Consumables used during repair may be chargeable.</li> <li>2. We are not currently able to repair electrical faults for any items that plug into mains power (lamps, blenders, etc.). You are welcome to bring along low-voltage electrical items such as those that use AAA, AA, C or D batteries, or mains powered items that require non-electrical repair e.g., drive belts, etc.</li> <li>3.
